

Ultimate Baseball Cage Instructions - Two persons are required to assemble cage.

- For the 35ft & 70ft cage the poles are spaced at 17.5ft intervals, for the 55ft at they are at 18.5ft intervals. Measure these points on the net and mark these points with a piece of string.
- Assemble the poles which are in 4 sections, 3 x tubes and 1 x foot. The foot has an inverted 'V'. Connect the poles together so that the button is on the same plane as the 'V', this is the plane that the net will lie against.
- Locate a corner of the net (where the 3 seams meet). Feed a pole under the net. Then place pole in corner and the net will rest on rings at the top of the pole. Carry out the same on other corner.
- Connect 2 guys to each ring using supplied snap hooks.
- With a person on each pole lift the net with the pole to an upright position placing the feet 10ft apart and push into the ground (if ground is hard hammer a steel rod/long cold chisel to make a starter hole).
- Place guys to hold poles vertical.
- Then using intervals place middle poles using same process. Middle poles only require one guy.
- Finally you may have to go around and adjust the guys to even the cage up at the same time make sure the netting is hooked on to the bottom of the poles.
